Title: Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone

Physical Description: DVD-151 min., CD-ROM/Audio Book-8 hours 17 min.; Read by Jim Dale. **RATED: PG** for some scary moments and mild language.

Summary: Harry Potter begins his first year at Hogwarts in this live-action feature film, based upon the first installment in J.K. Rowling's popular children's book series. On his 11th birthday, a young boy named Harry Potter learns that he is the orphaned son of two powerful wizards and discovers his own magical powers. Summoned from his unhappy life, he sets off for an English boarding school for wizards, where he hopes to discover the truth about his parents' mysterious deaths.

Title: Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets

Summary: Harry Potter finds danger awaiting him as he returns for his second year at Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry. Along with best friends Hermione and Ron, Harry sets out to uncover the dark force terrorizing the halls of Hogwarts.

Title: Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban

Summary: Harry becomes the target of a dangerous mass murderer after Sirius Black escapes from the Wizards' Prison at Azkaban Fortress. While learning to cope with the Dementors sent to protect the halls of Hogwarts, Harry learns the disturbing story of Black and more of his own history.

Summary: Harry becomes a competitor in a grueling battle for glory among three wizarding schools in this live-action feature film, based on the fourth book in the popular series by J.K. Rowling. In the course of the Triwizard Tournament, Harry must confront a deadly dragon, fierce water demons and an enchanted maze, only to find himself in the grasp of He Who Must Not Be Named.

Summary: Harry and his fellow Hogwarts students secretly prepare for battle with Lord Voldemort and his Death Eaters in this live-action adaptation of the fifth novel in J.K. Rowling's best-selling book series. As Harry returns to Hogwarts for his fifth year, the Ministry of Magic is working hard to keep news of the Dark Lord's return from the wizarding world. When the new Defense Against the Dark Arts teacher at school refuses to train the students in practical defense magic, a select group, led by Harry, form a secret club to hone their wizarding skills in preparation for an impending showdown between good and evil.
